As of 12th July 2020, the global death is 561617(5285new deaths) with 12551765(230370new cases) being infected and more than 50,00000 recovered from COVID-19 pandemic.

Ministry of Health and Population confirmed 144 new COVID-19 cases, with this the total number of confirmed case reached to 16945 and total death count has reached 38 as of 13<sup>th</sup> July 2020.
