## **Situation Report : COVID-19 Preparedness and Response**

As of 23rd July 2020, the global death is 619150 (7097 new deaths) with 15012731 (247225 new cases) being infected and more than 70,00000 recovered from COVID-19 pandemic.

Ministry of Health and Population confirmed 133 new COVID-19 cases, with this the total number of confirmed case reached to 18374 and total death count has reached 44 as of 24th of July 2020. 44th death of COVID-19 patient in Nepal: 85 years old female from Birgunj whose treatment was going on at Narayani hospital.

Ministry of Health and Population, Health Emergency Operation Centre (HEOC), is leading the responsewith the support of UN agencies and many other organizations. Nepal Red Cross Society(NRCS) is also the part of it, with the support of movement partners and government agencies at all levels NRCS is responding to the current situation. NRCS emergency operation Centre (EOC) was activated on 6<sup>th</sup> of February 2020 and 138 SITREPS released with the activities held in 77 District chapters of Red Cross. Nepal Red Cross
