As of 1st August 2020, the global death is 675060 (6142 new deaths) with 17396943 (289321 new cases) being infected and more than 70,00000 recovered from COVID-19 pandemic.

Ministry of Health and Population confirmed 246 new COVID-19 cases, with this the total number of confirmed case reached to 20332.

Ministry of Health and Population, Health Emergency Operation Centre (HEOC), is leading the responsewith the support of UN agencies and many other organizations. Nepal Red Cross Society(NRCS) is also the part of it, with the support of movement partners and government agencies at all levels NRCS is responding to the current situation.
